Successes:

- 2023-2024 The Rewards Intermediate Reading Program demonstrates an average improvement of 19% over 14 classes (4 schools)
 - Spruceland Elementary (high Indigenous population) avg. 39% gain.
- 2024-2025 Due to the success, Rewards Intermediate is now running/ starting in 15 schools.

Goal 2: Providing authentic learning experiences by connecting students with Indigenous educational leaders and authors to deepen their understanding of Indigenous knowledge and perspectives.

Successes:

- 17 high school classes are reading Monkey Beach or Son of a Trickster and attending presentations by author Eden Robinson..
- Presentations by Kevin Lamoureux, a renowned educator and advocate for truth and reconciliation to 4 high schools, Indigenous Education Department staff, DPM, as well as School Board Office staff.
